

COVID-19 GUIDE FOR U-PICK FARMS



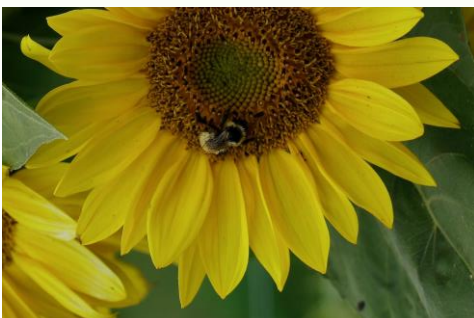
We are open!

We want your experience at our U-Picks to be positive and safe. Our U-Picks are abiding by the AHS and Government guidelines to safely operate during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Customers are required to assist in doing their part to have a safe and enjoyable time on our farms.

COVID PROTOCOLS ARE IN PLACE - EACH FARM WILL HAVE THEIR OWN RULES. Some farms may have switched to an appointment-based system to reduce crowding.

This is a Public Health Issue. Each Farm reserves the right to ask you to leave if you are being rude and abusive to staff, or are not adhering to the Safety Guidelines.



General Guidelines

EACH FARM WILL HAVE THEIR OWN RULES – CHECK ONLINE BEFORE HEADING FOR A VISIT

1. Come to the FARM if you are Healthy and show NO signs or Symptoms of COVID-19 (i.e. fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath) or have been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
2. Maintain Physical Distancing (2M) between staff and other customers
3. You must wash and/or sanitize your hands before and after entering the field.
 - Hand washing/sanitizing stations are available
4. Pick where you are assigned (NO EATING berries in the field)
5. Pick with a purpose! To ensure social distancing, no gathering or loitering will be permitted.
6. Each farm decides the number of people allowed to pick together in order to maintain social distance.
7. **ENJOY Your produce!**

The Good News:

COVID-19 is not a foodborne illness. The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) states that there is currently no evidence that food or food packages can be a source or route of transmission of the virus.
